

## Revenue

The library's tax rate for the operating budget is .1896 in DuPage County and .190 in Cook County.

The library receives its revenue from:

- Property taxes
- State grants
- Interest on investments
- Donations
- Copier and printer fees
- Non-resident library card fees
- Overdue fines
- Book rental fees
- Meeting Room rental fees
- Payment for lost materials

## Fines and Fees:

Materials that are returned late starting with the first day after the due date and are counted for every day the library is open.

- 10 cents - per day for books and magazines.
- 25 cents - per day for CD-ROMs, videos and non feature DVDs.
- \$1.00 - per day for feature DVDs and console games.
  
- Rental Books (pay as you read) - the first two days are free, including the day of check out. After that, a fee of 25 cents per day is charged until the book is returned.
- Items ordered from out of state - \$5.00 minimum charge (7/1/09)
- Returned Check - \$15.00
- Lost Materials - Contact the library
- Damaged Materials - Contact the library
- Processing - A fee of \$5.00 is charged for each replacement or lost item.
- Copy Machine – 10 cents per copy
- Printer – 10 cents b/w; 25 cents color
- Non-Resident Fee Card – This card is available to people who do not pay taxes to support a library. The fee is based on the average amount paid per household in the Indian Prairie Library District. The fee for 2016-2017 is \$194.00. The card may be used at any library.
- Meeting Room Rental Fee – Free for non-profit and governmental organizations. \$25.00 for four hours for for-profit entities.
